

Disci Privacy Policy

This privacy policy will explain how we (Disci) use the personal data we collect from you when you use our website.

What do we collect?

Disci collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (forename, surname, preferred language)
- Location data (IP-address)
- Data that the user has provided the platform
- Device information (device type, operating system, browser)

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Disci with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Create an account
- Use, view or interact with our website via your browser's cookies
- Fill in form data (e.g. sending a message, writing a review, ...)

How will we use your data?

Disci collects your data so that we can:

- Manage your account
- See analytics on how our product is used to improve upon our product
- Display the content you provided us through our product's features to other users of our product.

If you agree, anonymized data will also be made publicly available at analytics.woutfeys.be

How do we store your data?

Disci securely stores your data in Dworp, Belgium with salted and hashed passwords, and up-to-date security standards.

Disci will keep your *profile information, content generated via our product, Device information and Location data* until you take action to delete your account.

Once you take action, we will delete your data by deleting you throughout our database and deleting the information you provided us.

What are your **data protection rights**?

Disci would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request Disci for copies of your personal data.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that Disci correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Disci to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that Disci erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that Disci restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to Disci's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that Disci transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

What are **cookies**?

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information. When you visit our websites, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.

How do we **use cookies**?

Disci uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your experience on our website, including:

- Keeping you signed in
- Identifying you when needed (e.g. when publishing content on our site)
- Understanding how (and why) you use our website.

What **types of cookies** do we use?

There are a number of different types of cookies, however, our website uses:

- **Functionality** – Disci uses these cookies so that we can recognize you on our website and remember your previously selected preferences. These could include what language you prefer and location you are in. First-party cookies are used.
- **Analytics** – Disci uses these cookies to see how you use our website and to improve your experience.

How to **manage cookies**?

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, and the above website tells you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.
